If you are interested in **maths**, you could...

- Investigate distances to other countries in N or S America from the UK
- Cost a holiday to a country of your choice in N or S America. Include travel, accommodation, and visits to local tourist attractions.
- Find out how many dollars you will get for £100 etc. Cost up your holiday in dollars.
- Find out about the different time zones in America - are they the same or different?

If you are interested in **history**, you could...

- Find out about the history of a country in North / South America
- Create a timeline of key historical events from your chosen country.

If you are interested in **Physical Education**, you could...

- Keep a health and fitness diary including photos, videos, food lists, recipes about your healthy living journey.

If you are feeling **musical** you could you could...

- Explore Black American musicians and the different styles of music.

If you are interested in **geography**, you could...

- Find about some key figures in Black History- where did/do they come from? What is that village/town/ city like? What are the geographical features?

If you are interested in **Religious Education**, you could...

- Explore the religion or culture of a significant person in black history.

If you are feeling **creative** you could...

- Create a piece of artwork that reflect black history or a significant person that you have studied.

If you are interested in **maths**, you could...

- Create a time line of events from time in black history eg: Rosa Parks life.

If you are interested in **citizenship**, you could...

- Come up with your own definition of racism
- Find out about The Underground Railroad and what the people who were against the slave trade did to help.

- Research the contribution of significant individuals. You could focus on Rosa Parks, Harriet Tubman or Martin Luther King amongst many people who have changed history in different ways.
