Dear parents/carers,

We are looking forward to seeing your child in school during the lockdown as they have been identified as having parents in the key worker category or are vulnerable. Many of you have already shown us your ID if you are a key worker and told us which days you need your child to attend but if you haven't done so, please let us know when you drop your child off tomorrow. Your child(ren) has been allocated a place based on what you have told us you need and what we have available. Here is a full breakdown of the information as we understand it to be as of tonight:


What has stayed the same?

- Pupils will be completing the work they would have been doing if school was open as normal.
- Pupils start and finish at the same time slots that they normally have.
- If they are not attending some days, they should complete the work posted on **Seesaw/Tapestry** for their year group on days when they are not in school.
- School timetables will remain the same, including any PE and forest school slots and school dinners will also be available as usual using ParentPay to order them.
- Most pupils will work in the same year group that they are normally in, they will be based in the
 year group classrooms and will work with the staff normally attached to those year groups. (Please
 note that there are a few pupils who may have to work in another class if their classes were already
 full by the time a place was offered we will let you know directly if this is the case but they will
 work with either the year group above or below so it isn't too different for them).
- We are currently offering breakfast and after school club to those previously signed up.
 Breakfast club places are available for you to sign up to this term on a daily basis but for now, after
 school club places are only available for those previously signed up. (Please note that we can only
 offer these whilst we have good staffing levels. Should anything change, we would let you know
 as soon as possible but we apologise in advance if it is ever at short notice.)
- The pupils will join a **weekly assembly** online in school with Mrs Rogers in their classes (which will also be opened out to those home learning to attend).
- The children should continue to follow all our guidelines on Covid safety (washing hands, not touching each other or sharing personal resources etc). This includes not coming into school if you or anyone in your household shows symptoms of Covid and/or is having a test.
- We are continuing to ensure we have enhanced cleaning in place.
- Parents/carers should continue to wear masks whilst onsite and follow the one way system.
- If your child is due to be in school but isn't attending, you must call the office to let us know for safeguarding purposes the **attendance** and sickness procedures remain the same.
- They need to bring in a healthy snack and have a water bottle with them daily.
- Pupils will continue to wear full uniform as usual.

What will be different?

- Class sizes have been capped at **15** to allow for better social distancing to take place and reduce the risk of transmission (the classes will be a consistent group of 15 pupils).
- The children will be taught by staff in their year group but this might not always be their usual class teacher.
- Please remember to follow all the National Lockdown guidelines to help keep you and your child safe. We strongly recommend taking the opportunity to go for a family walk once a day and get
