

If you are feeling **musical** you could...

- Record or write a musical piece with all the different sounds of the animals in 'The Little Red Hen' story.
- Make a musical instrument using corn and other materials.
- Create a puppet show using the characters that you have made.

If you are feeling **curious** you could...

- Find out where different bread comes from and record this on a world map.
- Try different types of bread, which one do you like best? Can you record what each one tastes like? Smells like? Feels like? Looks like?
- Think/make as many different things as you can using eggs that a hen lays.

If you are feeling **creative** you could...

- Invent your own bread recipe using an unusual flavour.
- Make masks of the different characters in the 'The Little Red Hen' story.
- Make varied shaped bread rolls using salt dough.
- Make puppets using the characters from the 'Little Red Hen', to help you re-tell the story.

- Visit a farm and keep a record of the type and number of animals you see.
- Sing some counting songs. Can you think of any songs that have any animals that can be found on a farm?
