Topic for Term 2:

Weather

And Seasons

Personal, social and emotional development

The new children in Cherry class have settled in and are now joining in with our daily routine. There is so much to look forward to this term including Halloween, Bonfire Night and Christmas. This term we will be learning about the different types of weather and the four seasons leading up to Christmas.

At home, support your child to stop and listen when someone is talking to them and begin to take turns in games (my turn, your turn).

Communication, language, reading and writing

This term we will be looking at short poems about the weather with the children and encouraging them to join in. We will continue to sing familiar nursery rhymes with the children and will be providing them with lots of mark making opportunities throughout the session to put on display.

Physical development

This term we will be continue to encourage confidence to explore the outside environment to develop the children's gross motor skills as well as providing fine motor activities.

Maths development

We will be singing number songs with the children and supporting their understanding of what numbers are by counting the children and looking at numbers in the environment. We will be using our number line to recognise numbers 0-5. When you practice your nursery rhymes at home, please try to include some with numbers within them such as 5 Little Ducks or our favourite 5 Cheeky Monkeys.

Knowledge and understanding of the world

We will be looking at all the different types of weather and discussing the weather in each of the four seasons. We will be looking at appropriate clothing we should wear and experimenting with waterproof/non waterproof materials.

At home, start to introduce the words relating to weather such as: cold, hot, sun, cloud and sky.

Expressive arts and design

As part of our topic we will be creating a display by using different materials and techniques. We will also be discussing colours and textures. To help us to learn our poems we will be adding actions to help us remember.
