Each parent or person of parental responsibility has a single vote for one Primary Parent Governor candidate regardless of how many primary children they have in an Aspirations academy.

All ballot returns are kept confidential and are reported anonymously.

The closing date for votes is **3.30pm on Wednesday 16th November 2022**. This applies both for votes recorded online and for the receipt of hard copy votes either posted or brought in person to the school office.

Notification of the successful candidate will be made on the websites of the relevant academies by Wednesday 23rd November 2022 unless there is a tie and it becomes necessary to conduct a further election process.
