## Re: Reception Class Tapestry Journal

Over the next few days you should receive a notification on your Tapestry account to inform you that your child's learning journey is available for you to download. In order to download it, we suggest logging in to the desktop version rather than the app. You will then be able to download the journal in bulk onto your home device or USB. Only children's individual observations are available to download, unfortunately group observations will not be.

The learning journey for your child will be available for you to download between **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> and Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July**. Please make sure that you download the learning journey within this window as after this date you will not be able to access it.

If you require help or support in downloading, then feel free to ring and speak to a member of staff who will be more than willing to help you or answer any questions. There is also an online tutorial for parents to read on how to do this with more information
