Dear Year 4 Parents and Carers,

Trip to Cadbury World – Tuesday 30th April 2024

As part of our science unit of learning in Term 5, we have an exciting opportunity to visit Cadbury World in Birmingham. Children will watch the Cadbury team making a variety of chocolate treats, and learn all about the chocolate-making techniques as well as the history of Cadbury during their tour of the factory.

We hope that all children will attend as it will be a unique experience that will give them a fascinating insight into the heritage of Cadbury's chocolate. They will travel through a variety of zones within the factory learning about chocolate making, and will follow the cocoa bean on its journey through history. They will also have the chance to dress up as real factory workers as they explore how the Cadbury factory manufactures their popular products. This trip will give them the chance to find out about careers in a factory, innovation and food services as well as supporting our curriculum objectives.

The trip will take place on **Tuesday 30th April 2024**. The children will be **leaving school at 9am** and **returning back to school by 3pm**. They will be travelling by coach and will need a packed lunch, including a drink, **in a named plastic bag**. If your child has free school meals, a meal will be provided for them.

The cost for the trip, which includes entrance to Cadbury World and the coach, is **£22.00**. Please give consent for your child to attend this trip and make payment via ParentPay.

As always, this is a voluntary contribution. However, if we do not receive enough funds, the trip will not go ahead.
