Dear Parents/Carers,

On **Monday 22nd January 2024, Year 6** will be participating in the Junior Citizens workshops at Rewley Road Fire Station, Oxford. The visit includes opportunities for pupils to experience many different scenarios that help them to learn how to deal with dangers, hazards and difficult situations that could occur in real life such as stranger and internet danger and children get to practise making a 999 call.

Pupils will need to wear school uniform on this day but it is suggested that girls wear trousers or if wearing a skirt, they wear thick tights or leggings underneath as the sessions are practical and pupils will be kneeling on the floor including practising the recovery position.
