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Dear Parents and Carers of pupils in **Sycamore Class**

Exciting opportunity for all Year 5 pupils - Greatworth Hall Farm Trip – 24th April 2024

This academic year, we are delighted to have partnered up once again with local farm Greatworth Hall for a fifth year to visit the education centre and farm there. All learning from the visits, and from any Forest School sessions that take place this year in our school wildlife area, will link to our science topics; describing life processes and reproduction in plants and animals whilst refining their teamwork, communication, listening and responding skills. Linked to their geography topic, the children will observe, measure, record and present the human and physical features in the local area using a range of methods, including sketch maps, plans and graphs, and digital technologies.

In order to attend, your child must have their Forest School appropriate clothing including:

- waterproofs if wet; sun cream and hat if sunny or coat if cold
- welly boots/sturdy waterproof walking boots
- a spare pair of suitable clean indoor shoes i.e trainers (to be brought in a named carrier bag)
- packed lunch including water bottle and healthy snack

Pupils will travel by minibus and will need a packed lunch for their visits. **Sycamore Class will visit on Wednesday 24th April 2024.**

The cost of the trip is **£12.00** and consent and payment can be made on Parentpay. If we do not receive enough funds, the trip cannot go ahead.
