YEAR 4

Driving Question: Why should humans work harder to protect habitats and the environment? Non-fiction: Explanation text

Literacy

We are beginning this term by focusing on a non-fiction explanation text about jellyfish. We will be improving our writing by changing grammar and vocabulary to ensure consistency. We will also be using our knowledge of clauses to compose sentences to vary structure. Later in the term, we will be looking at our Talk for Reading text 'Journey to the River Sea'. As a class we will be reading a range of non-fiction books. This will help us understand how to find information from books and stories.

Maths

This term we will focus on length and perimeter, fractions, decimals and the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

In fractions, we will be looking at how to identify, add and subtract fractions with the same denominator and show how to represent fractions using different models. <u>https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z3rbg82</u>

We will be playing tennis, as well as learning gymnastic skills. Tennis will be taught outside so please ensure that your child has the appropriate clothing as the weather can be cold and wet. Science and Geography

This term we will be looking at sorting animals based on their habitats. We will also look at food chains and how animals live together. As we progress through the term, we will integrate some PHSE into our lessons. We aim to investigate how much plastic is used, its impact on the environment and how we can make a difference. You could watch the news or read recent articles to find out more about the damage that is happening to our planet.

Each week we also work on the importance of e-safety, making sure we stay safe online and understand why it's important to follow e-safety rules.
