

If you would like to make something, you could...

- Make a model of a character from your favourite story.
- Use material to create a puppet of your favourite character.

If you are feeling *musical* you could you could...

- Use old plastic bottles/bins/household items to create and sustain a musical rhyme. Film it, or bring things in to perform to the class.

If you are feeling *scientific* you could...

- Stage your own experiment testing different materials/ comparing different materials and write a report about it.
- Plant your own seeds or bulbs and create your own plant diary to jot down the plants progress.

If you are interested in *PE*, you could...

- Practise your ball skills and make up your own game. Take pictures / make a video of your playing it and write the rules down to teach others.
- Look at balances, movements and sequences. Create a poster to show these.
