YEAR 4

How can we, as advertisers, convince someone to buy our chocolate bar?

Literacy

We are beginning this term by exploring how to use different sentence structures and fronted adverbials to write around a fantasy theme (The Magician's Shop). The children will build on this to create descriptive writing using Charlie and the Chocolate Factory as inspiration. We will then use these skills to write a persuasive advert linked to our chocolate topic.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on decimals and money. In our decimals topic, we will begin by identifying amounts equivalent to fractions and apply this knowledge to solving money problems. This term we will also be focusing again on our times tables in preparation for the Year 4 test in June. The children need to know these times tables by heart so practise at home will be very beneficial. Time Table Rock Stars (TTRS) is great for practising times tables.

Physical Education

Athletcis and handball will be our main sports this term. We will be practising essential ball skills and learning basic tactics to engage in games of handball. This will be taught **outside** so please ensure that your child has the appropriate clothing. PE Kit is **white t-shirt**, **black shorts or jogging bottoms and trainers**. Please ensure that your child has a **black sweatshirt**. For your child's safety, earrings must be removed before any PE lesson.

Art

This term we will be focusing on colour, tone and shading. We will apply these skills to our creative curriculum topic by drawing sweets and designing chocolate packaging.

History

Science
