## Trip to Cotswold Wildlife Park – Thursday 27th June 2024

As part of our topic next term, Reception classes will be taking part in an exciting visit to Cotswold Wildlife Park. We will be visiting on Thursday 27th June and the children will be travelling by coach and minibus. The cost for the trip will be £20.00, payable via ParentPay. This includes travel and entry to the park.

On the day, we will leave school at 9am so children will need to be in school promptly, dressed in school uniform. After a fun day at the wildlife park, we will then return to school before usual pick up time. Children will need to bring a packed lunch, including a drink in a named rucksack that they can easily carry. We suggest that food items should be in disposable packaging, so that as much as possible can be thrown away after lunch to make bags lighter. Depending on the weather, your child should also bring a light-weight waterproof coat, sun hat and have sun cream applied before coming to school. No other bags or resources will be needed that day.

Alongside our staff, we are also in need of parent/carer volunteers to accompany the children on the trip. If you are available to support us on this visit, then come and see a member of the Reception team. Please note, that if you can volunteer, we cannot accommodate younger siblings on the visit too.

Please tell a member of staff if your child suffers from travel sickness or if there are any other medical issues that we should be aware of prior to the day. We also ask that you kindly make payment by Friday 14th June on ParentPay.
