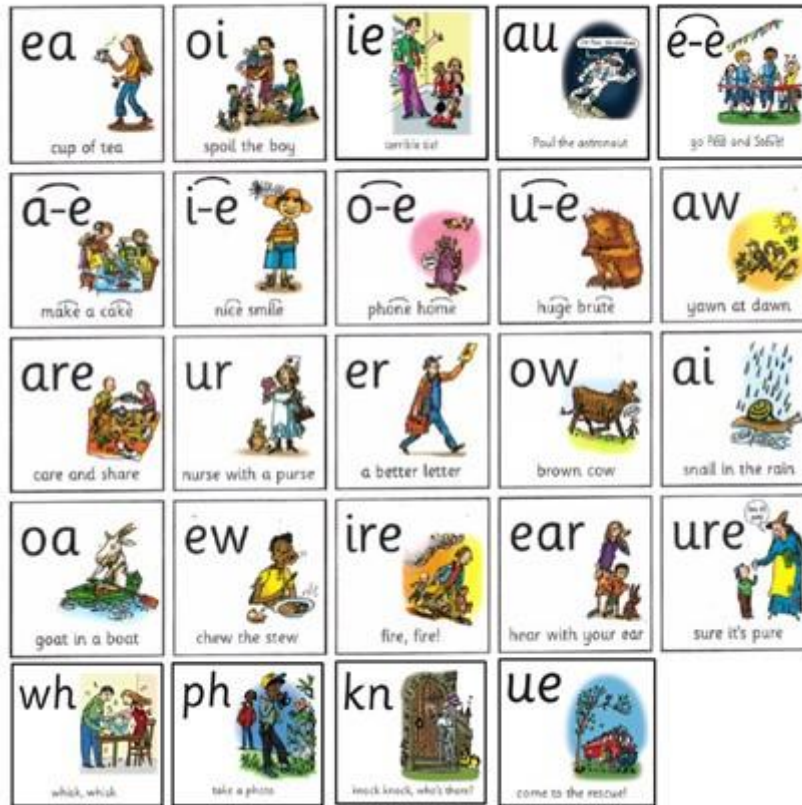
Our topic for the term: **Toys - Focusing on history, design technology and science.**

Literacy
