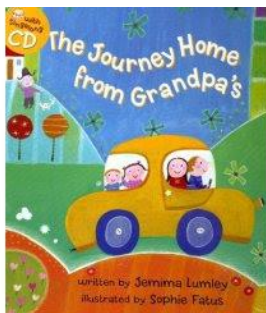
The Journey Home from Grandpa's

Personal, social and emotional development:

During this term we are welcoming more children in to Cherry class and will be supporting them in settling into the rules and routines of Cherry class. We will also be learning about different types of transport in our area and at home.

Communication, language, reading and writing

This term we will be reading 'The Journey Back From Grandpa's' story with the children and encouraging them to join in and talk about the pictures and using new vocabulary. We will continue to sing familiar nursery rhymes with the children. We will be providing the children with lots of mark making opportunities throughout the session to put on display.



Physical development

We will encourage the children's gross motor skills using our play equipment outside. We have many activities that will strengthen and develop fine motor skills.

Maths development

We will be singing number songs with the children and supporting their understanding of what numbers are by counting the children and looking at numbers in the environment. While looking at different transport we will be sorting them into the different types, looking at shapes and counting their features. The children will be looking and comparing sizes of vehicles and transport.

Knowledge and understanding of the world

We will be looking at vehicles and transport and discussing what they are used for and what they look like.

Expressive arts and design

As part of our topic we will be creating a display by using different materials and techniques. We will also be discussing colours and textures.
