Dear Parents and Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that Key Stage 1 will be visiting Little Rollright Farm during the week commencing 27th April 2026. This exciting visit will give the children a valuable opportunity to experience life on a farm and see animals up close.

The trip links directly with the science objectives for both year groups, including learning about living things, life cycles and food chains. The visit will support the children's classroom learning through hands-on experiences and discussions with the farm staff.

The dates for each class are as follows:

- **Monday 27th April – Redwood Class**
- **Tuesday 28th April – Maple Class**
- **Wednesday 29th April – Hazel Class**
- **Thursday 30th April – Holly Class**

The farm has kindly subsidised the visit, which means the cost is **£11** per child (which includes the cost of coach travel). Please make payment via Arbor by **Friday 17th April 2026**.

Children should wear their normal school uniform on the day. They will also need:

- A packed lunch
- A pair of wellies in a bag (these should be easy for the children to change into and out of when we arrive and before we leave the farm)

We are looking forward to a fantastic learning experience for the children and appreciate your support in preparing them for the visit. This is a voluntary contribution, however, if we do not received enough funds to cover the cost of the trip then it will not be able to go ahead.
